- 1. All Costume Contest participants must be participating in the Western Rivers Livestock Expo in either sheep, goat, swine, or cattle on Saturday, June 14th.
- 2. Deadline to enter is 12:00 pm, Friday June 13th. Registration forms can be found at the front desk in the foyer of the Expo Center.
- 3. One winner will be chosen per division.
- 4. Divisions:
 - a. Novice- Children from toddlers able to walk (may be accompanied by a parent) to children under the age of 9yrs old as of January 1, 2025
 - b. Junior- Ages 9-13 as of January 1, 2025
 - c.Senior-Ages 14-21 as of January 1, 2025
- 5. Youth will be required to furnish one animal to use in the contest.
- 6. Contestants must follow rules and guidelines found in the KY State Fair Premium book concerning unethical practices in fitting and exhibiting livestock.
- 7. Judging breakdown is as follows: 50% creativity, 25% participant's interaction with the animal, 25% participant is having fun.
